Anzac Day, one of the biggest days on the RSL calendar, is on **Friday 25th April**. This year marks a special milestone—100 years ago, in 1925, a dedicated group of local men organised the very first Anzac Day ceremony in Cleveland, and its simple yet powerful tradition has been faithfully repeated ever since. We invite our community to join us in paying tribute to the brave men and women who served and sacrificed for our country. It's an important day for reflection and remembrance, and we encourage everyone to come together in honour of their legacy. *See pages 12-15*.

Following that first Anzac Day ceremony in 1925, on 11th May 1925, approximately 40 Returned Servicemen attended a meeting in the Cleveland Masonic Hall. This group of men, headed by

C.C.Campbell, a South African and World War I veteran, conceived the idea of organising the Returned Serviceman of the district. G.Wort convened this meeting at which was formed the Redlands Sub-Branch of the Returned Soldiers' and Sailors' Imperial League of Australia (RSSILA), later to be renamed the Returned Soldier's, Sailor's and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia (RSSAILA).

Therefore, this May, Redlands RSL Sub Branch is turning 100 YEARS OLD! It's been a century of growth, unforgettable memories, amazing people, and incredible times, and we look forward to celebrating this monumental milestone with our community!

To help us celebrate, we have exclusive merchandise available for purchase at reception, including polo shirts, hats, coffee mugs, stubbie coolers, and keyrings. We will be hosting a Centenarian

Luncheon for dignitaries and invited guests to honour this monumental achievement. Our Major Promotion in May will see us giving away \$100's for our 100 years (it's actually \$20K, but that


